Enrollment Deposit

Once again, CONGRATULATIONS on your acceptance to Hellenic College Holy Cross. One of the most important next steps for you to complete is the submission of your deposit. Just as your acceptance offer serves as an invitation for you to join our community, your deposit serves as your “RSVP”, or commitment to come to HCHC for your studies. Your deposit cues us to complete several more important steps in order to prepare for your arrival.

- If you plan to be an on-campus resident, please send your enrollment deposit of \$500.00.
- If you plan to be a commuter, please send your enrollment deposit of \$200.00.

We accept the following payment methods: Check, money order or credit card (MasterCard, VISA, American Express, and Discover). Be sure to include your name on the memo line of the check or money order which can be made out to: **Hellenic College, Inc.** To make a credit card payment, please contact the Office of the Bursar at 617-850-1232 so they may process your deposit. Please note, deposits are non-refundable after **July 1st**.

Financial Clearance (Housing, Medical, and Health Insurance Forms)

Once you have remitted your Enrollment and Housing Deposits (if applicable) you will receive a Financial Clearance Packet of forms and a checklist from the Office of the Bursar. The Housing Form and Health & Medical Form are included in this packet and must be completed and returned to the School prior to your arrival on campus. Students that fail to submit these documents will not be admitted to the dormitory or be allowed to begin classes.

Health Insurance

Student health insurance is mandatory in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
